What does the future look like for a single mother in Cameroon who didn't finish school? Thanks to donors like you, she could become a tailor, open her own restaurant, or provide basic medical care in her community.

These paths are possible through a vocational training program offered by our partner, Centre de Promotion

de la Femme et de la Famille. The training, provided by Cuso International volunteers, provides women like Thérèse the skills and confidence to earn their own income, take care their families and contribute to their communities.

Thérèse hopes to offer medical support and basic healthcare services in her community.

"Thanks to my training, I am not only more confidant in myself, but also have the recognition from my family. My neighbors call me "docta." - Thérèse

You may remember Luzmila from a previous update. She helped launch a community

soup kitchen to serve food to families in her community on the outskirts of Lima. Peru.

Thanks to your generosity, we're happy to report that her kitchen is still operating and that she's recently received training from Cuso International volunteers on

urban gardening as part of the MUSA project in Peru. She's now created a thriving vegetable garden next to the kitchen.

You're helping Luzmila acquire the tools and skills she needs to sustainably grow fresh produce for her kitchen. Now, she no longer relies on more expensive food markets outside her community. She can also sell her produce in local markets.

You're helping Luzmila build autonomy for herself and her community.
