Feminist schools are paving a path to equality and leadership.

In Peru, 2020 ushered in a new era for women's equality and inclusion. Women achieved parity in public offices and secured leadership positions in the Cabinet and Supreme Court.

None of this would have been possible without the hard work of feminist organizations across the country, including two that are supported by Cuso International's Women's Voice and Leadership project.

Your generosity has helped this ambitious project support local partners who are supporting women through campaigns and

feminist schools across Peru. Women who attend these schools are given the information and tools to challenge gender norms, demand their human rights, and get involved in politics.

Ayesha, a 32-year-old activist and mother of two, says her participation in a feminist school was transformative.

"The project has helped me to reconfirm and solidify how important it is for women to break from the system and to become the actors of true change ourselves."

In a previous update, we introduced you to a determined change-maker named Lourdes of Honduras. With the support of Cuso International and its local partner, Centro de Estudios Marinos, Lourdes taught women in her community how to fish sustainably.

Recently, these women showed just how far they've come by participating in a fishing tournament. The top three fisherwomen were rewarded with additional training and seed capital to expand their own fishing enterprises.

#### You're uplifting entrepreneurs in Tanzania like Genovefa.



Genovefa knows all about the challenges of growing a small business, but thanks to donors like you, she knows how to overcome them too.

After retiring from teaching, Genovefa started to grow her peanut-butter business through a program supported by Cuso International in Tanzania.

The program supports new entrepreneurs through

training workshops and start-up funding. It's helped Genovefa buy a peanut roasting and grinding machine, which boosted her production and her confidence as a womenowned business.

Thanks to your support, Genovefa is challenging social norms that restrict women to domestic work and underestimate them as successful business owners.
